Built on the hospital campus of Yavapai Regional Medical Center, the Prescott Outpatient Surgical Center combines an outpatient surgical center with a recovery care center. Four operating rooms, four overnight patient rooms and associated support facilities completed the building program. Healing gardens viewed from the patient rooms and the lobby, as well as natural daylighting throughout the building, offer the patient a more comfortable environment. The project was challenged by a limited site and the necessity of maintaining operations and access to the existing outpatient surgical center while construction was completed on the new building - a mere 4 feet from the existing. Because the site was further challenged by significant ground-water, the structural foundation and floor slab were isolated to allow for drainage and to mitigate migration of water into the building. The staff at the Prescott Outpatient Surgical Center have described their building as, "very light and open."
